5. **Trip to Guatemala** – we have three people committed at this time.

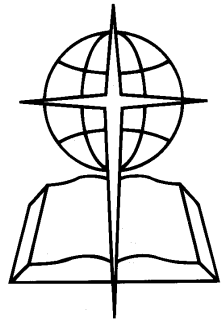

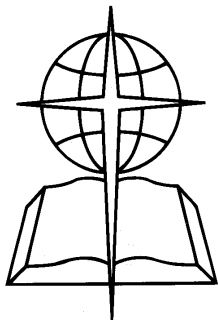

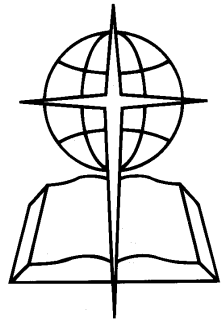
3. **Recommendation from the Pastoral Counseling Center Study Committee:**

Rev. Larry Sorah led the congregation in singing "Love Lifted Me".

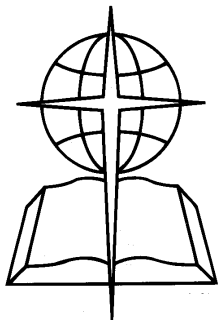
Rev. Kenneth Elkins recognized the members of our churches who have passed away during this past year; reading I Thessalonians 4:13-18 and then led in prayer.

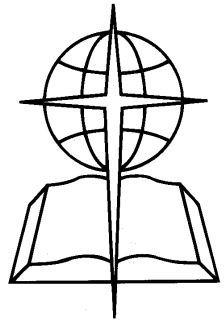
McMINN-MEIGS ASSOCIATION OF BAPTISTS, TENNESSEE

BIG SKY ASSOCIATION DESCRIPTION:

- *Covers the 13 counties in the Southeast corner of Montana (two counties have no church);
- *41,000 square miles (nearly equivalent to the square mileage of the entire state of Tennessee) with a Population of 50,000+ (McMinn County has a population of 50,000+), two counties have a population of 1,000 or less;
- *Average distance between communities is 60 miles with only a few ranches between each community;
- *80% of economy is based on ranching: average ranch 45,000 acres (40 acres is needed to support one cow, whereas in McMinn-Meigs 40 cows could graze on 40 acres).
- *Most Counties have only one High School per county covering many square miles;
- *There are 12 churches in the Association (the church in Terry is currently closed): the Sunday average attendance is around 40: Largest congregation will run 120 & smallest 8;
- *All the active churches currently have pastors. This is the first church for half of the pastors. Many have not attended seminary and are bi-vocational. Isolation and loneliness affects many of the pastors and their families;
- *The Association has the feel of one large family. Actually all of Southeast Montana is like one big community. Miles City is located in the middle of the area and is considered the hub. The only Wal-Mart in Eastern Montana (East of Billings to North/South Dakota borders and Wyoming border to the Canadian border) is located in Miles City;
- *The Association has reached about 5% of the population. The goal is to reach 10% by the year 2020. The partnership with McMinn-Meigs could be of great assistance in this endeavor.

THE CHURCHES OF BIG SKY ASSOCIATION:

1. Alzada - Rangeland Ministries Baptist Church, Pastor: This is a very small community, the church has about 8 members. There is a large area around the church, but sparsely populated. The church has a potential of reaching the area, but need good facilities. The current structure is literally about to cave-in and aside from a miracle will probably do so in the near future. A new location if one can be found or built would be the best solution.
2. Baker - Lakeview Baptist Church, Pastor Sheldon Sorenson: lvbaptist@midrivers.com This church has good facilities, has a fairly new Family Life Center. The Pastor is also a Master Carpenter. They offer Awana, VBS and other Community outreach events. The third week of August is the County Fair. Baker is an Oil Rich town.
3. Circle - First Baptist Church, Pastor Mike Bartleson: mibart@midrivers.com The Pastor is also a teacher and football coach at the local school. The building has some structural issues. Could also need help with VBS, Community Outreach, the County Fair is the third week of August.
4. Colstrip - First Baptist Church, Pastor Mike Andrews: pastor_mike_andrews@hotmail.com This church is located in a coal rich community. The church facility seems to be in good shape, they could use help with VBS, Community Outreach.
5. Forsyth - First Baptist Church, Pastor Bill Sikes: bandcsikes@rangeweb.net (Bill is the former Pastor of East Niota). Doug and Karen Reynolds, formerly of Calhoun, moved to Forsythe three years ago and are active members of the church. This is one of the larger churches in Association located in one of the larger communities. They could use help with VBS, Community Outreach and Construction of their new Family Life Center.
6. Glendive - First Baptist Church, Pastor Roy Perry: royperry3@aol.com Their Educational Building needs structural work also they could use help with VBS and community Outreach. The Pastor is interested in starting a church in Wibaux about 30 miles east of Glendive. Teams could assist with this by doing prayerwalking, door-to-door survey, block parties, etc.
7. Hysham - Hysham Baptist Church, Pastor Joe Raleigh: raleigh_joe@yahoo.com (East Niota Baptist has a partnership relationship with this church and have sent four summer mission teams to the church since 2007 to do VBS,

Community Outreach and Construction). Small Community, people are hard to reach, has a new Parsonage which still needs some work to complete.

8. Jordan - Jordan Community Bible Church, Pastor K.J. Ellington: kellington@midrivers.com (First Baptist Church of Englewood sent a volunteer mission team of 49 people to Jordan in the summer of 2010 to do VBS and other work). KJ has a strong three to five year vision for the church. The church has some drainage issues around the parking lot side of the church that needs to be corrected.

9. Lame Deer - Morning Star Baptist Church, Pastor Dean Smith: missiondriven@juno.com Pastor Dean is doing a good job ministering to this Northern Cheyenne Indian Community. The church also includes an elementary school. This year a youth group from Candies Creek in Cleveland went out and did an excellent job working in the community. Any team going here will have to be well schooled in protocol of working on an Indian reservation.

10. Miles City - Valley Drive Baptist Church, Pastor Jeff Cahill: pastorjeff@midrivers.com The church facility is good, partner churches would focus on VBS, Community Outreach. Miles City is the hub of the 13 county area and has the only Wal-Mart in the vast area east of Billings.

11. Sidney - Fellowship Baptist Church, Pastor Jordan Hall: truelight321@hotmail.com The church has a good facility. Partnership teams would focus on VBS, Community Outreach and Leadership training.

12. Terry - Is Currently Closed

13. Vida - Vida Community Church, Pastor Duane Giddis: duanegiddis2001@yahoo.com This church is not part of the Association, but they do have a Southern Baptist Pastor. The Association is working to bring them into the fold.

THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME OF THE IDENTIFIED NEEDS:

*Most churches could use assistance getting their churches winterized;

*An immediate need, revival preachers for the fall of 2010 for GPS emphasis "Across Montana 2010". They are doing this emphasis in the fall because of calving during the spring (many church members are Ranchers).

*Pastors and Wives Retreat (Family Retreat) to be led by volunteers from McMinn-Meigs;

*VBS and Camps;

*Community evangelistic outreach projects such as help working the local County Fairs, block parties, etc.;

*Spiritual renewal: Bible studies, Sunday School, leadership development training, Discipleship Training, long term teaching, etc.

*Encouragement: ongoing communication with Pastors and their families to help overcome isolation and loneliness;

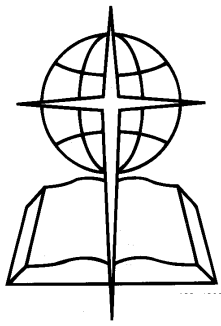
*Construction: church painting, inside remodeling, ideas on improving parking lots, repairing structural issues in several of the churches, etc.

* Work in the local Nursing Homes (there is at least one in every community);

* To do community projects such as, cut grass, repair homes, help on ranches, etc.

DESCRIPTION OF THE McMINN-MEIGS ASSOCIATION OF BAPTISTS:

- This Association is Located in Southeast Tennessee halfway between Chattanooga to the South and Knoxville to the North;
- The largest of the two counties covered by this Association is McMinn with a population of 50,000+, Meigs County has a population of 10,000+;
- There are 60 churches in McMinn County and 11 in Meigs County. The churches range in size from 1,400+ to 51 with an average membership of 321;
- In McMinn County there are three School Systems (Athens, Etowah and McMinn County) consisting of four elementary, one Middle School, seven K-8 and two High Schools. Meigs County has two elementary, one Middle and one High School;
- Unlike Southeast Montana there are probably over 250 churches of all denominations located in these two counties;

- Due to the economic downturn McMinn and Meigs are facing high unemployment as several factories have closed over the past few years. People in this area will sometimes have to drive to Knoxville, Oak Ridge Chattanooga or further to find employment. There are farms in the area, some large and serve as the primary source of family income. Mayfield Dairy which processes milk and ice cream and other dairy products originated in Athens (the county seat for McMinn County) and is still in operation there.

SOME OF THE IDENTIFIED NEEDS:

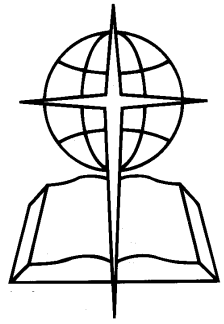
- Women at the Well, a local ministry for women with substance abuse issues and other issues that may have landed them in jail. They always have need for volunteer assistance;
- Miracle Lake, is a ministry for men similar to Women at the Well;
- Opportunities to help with Bible Schools and do community outreach for some of our churches;
- Help with Habitat for Humanity;
- Help with various needs at our Association Camp Cherokee;
- Pastors to be available to come do Revivals as invited;
- Help at a local Christian Camp Livingstones.

PARTNERSHIP POSSIBILITIES AND BENEFITS:

The objective of this partnership is to have churches from McMinn-Meigs and Big Sky Associations to come alongside, to encourage and assist one another in expanding the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ in their local area and to the ends of the earth.

This agreement will be basically informal which is reflective of the both Associations, however the following will help us understand that we will be working together for the good of both Associations and the furtherance of the Kingdom of God. The following are some of the aspects of this agreement

1. Churches in McMinn-Meigs Association will be encouraged to develop partnerships with churches in the Big Sky Association and send teams as needed and requested to help the partnered churches (see suggested Partnership Guidelines on page 4 below).
2. Churches in the Big Sky Association can partner with churches in the McMinn-Meigs Association to send teams as needed and requested to help the partnered churches (see suggested Partnership Guidelines on page 4 below).
3. The Association offices of both Associations can and should serve as a clearinghouse, of sorts, to help connect churches to churches, help with scheduling and other needed items.
4. That both Associations can and should develop teams to be sent to the other Association as special needs arise and requests are made.
5. That the Directors of Missions for Big Sky and McMinn-Meigs communicate regularly to keep abreast of ongoing needs and changes in leadership, etc. If face-to-face meetings are necessary during the course of the partnership then they will be arranged as needed.
6. All requests for volunteers can be channeled through the appropriate committees of both Associations or directly church to church. Items, such as funding, travel, meals, etc., should be discussed by the appropriate committees, individuals or churches resulting in a plan spelling out who will be responsible for what. If a church to church trip is arranged outside the involvement of the association offices the churches are requested to notify the association office for record keeping purposes.
7. Both Associations would be able to develop training sessions for volunteers. As needed and requested, to orient them regarding what to and what not to do for the area they will be serving. These sessions would be very beneficial for all teams before they go to their area of service. Sessions could be led by the Director of Missions or other member of the Association Missions Committee/Team.

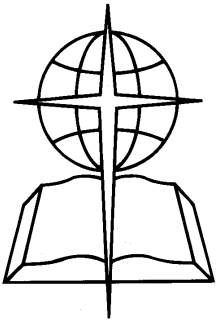
8. Volunteer requests should be filtered through the Association Office. However in a church to church partnership this will not be necessary except for copying information to the Association Offices. Upon completion of a project the group is requested to submit a copy of their report for the Partnership file.
9. This will not be an exclusive partnership meaning churches from other Associations will continue to be welcome to send teams. The only request is that the Association offices of both Associations be notified when this occurs for the Partnership file.
10. The partnership will be evaluated annually to determine the effectiveness of the relationship, tweak what needs to be tweaked, etc.
11. This partnership will be for a minimum of three years. After three years the partnership will be evaluated to determine if it should continue.

SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR PARTNERING CHURCHES

As churches from Montana and Tennessee begin to partner, this guide to partnerships should be considered. Please consider these suggestions they are designed to help the partnership be a benefit to both THE churches and the kingdom of God.

1. Pray. Ask our Heavenly Father if He would have you to enter a partnership. If yes, ask Him to guide you into a partnership for the right reasons: to build up His Church, His Kingdom and to glorify His name. Finally, ask Him to guide you to the right partner that shares these goals.
2. Before a partnership is agreed upon. The pastors of both churches should have several conversations by phone or visit. Here are some talking guides:
 - a. Talk about the goals of both churches for the next five years. (a partnership may be for just three but still look at where the churches feel Christ would have them be in five.)
 - b. What are the strengths and weaknesses of both churches? How can each church help each other in overcoming the weaknesses and maximizing the strengths?
 - c. What are some of the major events in the churches calendar year? Would a mission team from one of the partnering church facilitate this event? Would this be a training team that could help the church on the mission field accomplish this task or should the mission team do the task the first year and train the church on the mission field to do it the next year?
 - d. What are some major events in the communities over a calendar year that a church can take advantage of with servant evangelism ministry events? Would these events require help from the partnering church?
 - e. How big of a mission group would be needed?
 - f. What about housing for the groups? Are there RV hookups somewhere?
3. As God blesses the church on the mission field over the years, what new needs might arise?
 - a. Will the leadership base in the church need to grow?
 - b. Could the partnering church give leadership training for these new leaders whether it is deacons, teachers or outreach leaders?
 - c. Will the church need to expand in the next five years? What will that look like? How can the partnership prepare the church to face these challenges?
4. Be aware that even with the best of partnership, things will change. Go into the partnership realizing that not everything has to be accomplished in the first year. The planning will get better with each year.

Realize that help goes both ways: the bigger church is not necessarily the healthiest or the best fit for a partnership. Churches need to spend time with one another to determine the best fit both ways.

DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS REPORT

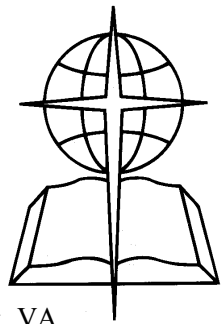
Rev. E. Ray Luck, Director of Missions

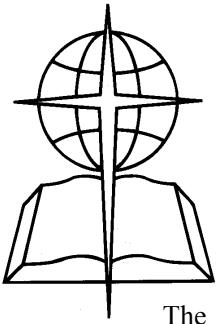

MISSIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

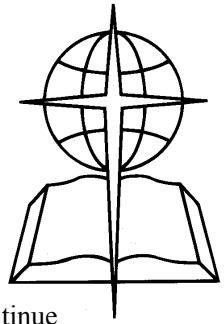
