- 2. That each church be given this year to come into compliance.
- 3. That each church which does not come into compliance will be brought to the association annual meeting in 2016 and be brought for dismissal at that time according to our bylaws.

We believe that grace should reign in our hearts at this time. We believe that every opportunity should be given to find a suitable solution to each church as we seek to honor our Lord and witness to our world of a risen Savior.

Are we committing ourselves to follow Him with our lives, talents, and resources, to the Glory of God and for His Kingdom?

During the Baptist Women's World Day of Prayer on November 3rd, we were challenged in our Bible study and prayer that God requires faithfulness, God blesses a life of faithfulness and a life of faithfulness is not an option for the Christian. All around the globe for 24 hours thousands of women were praying for specific requests on seven continents. Our prayer: keep us faithful and obedient.

We have a responsibility to 'the least of these' to pray and be involved.

August 15th, the Mission Education and Involvement Training centered on being an "All-for-YOU" leader. We recognize our need for accountability, possibility, and sustainability. Through training, we can be ready for the new church year armed with new resources and new relationships with the foundation of God's Truths.


CHILDREN'S BIBLE DRILL REPORT



Stewardship Committee Report:

Rev. Mike Farmer, Chairman of the Stewardship Committee, presented the Treasurer's Report for the Association and for Camp Cherokee. The report was approved as printed.

Business Session:

New Business:

- Rev. Michael Hodsden, Moderator read a letter from Conasauga Baptist Church regarding their decision to withdraw its membership from our Association. (copy attached) No action was required.
- 2. Ken Jones, Chairman of the Personnel Committee reported that Rev. Clayton Dunsmore has been called as the Interim Director of Missions for our Association subject to the approval of the Executive Board. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Rev. I also attended the VBS clinic at First Baptist Decatur and lead a class. I met with the Stewardship Committee, and visited Camp Cherokee and talked with the caretaker. Motion 1: 56 Yes votes and 13 No votes.


Motion 2: 56 Yes votes and 9 No votes.

Rev. Jon Hathcock, Pastor of East Athens Baptist Church welcomed everyone to this called meeting and opened with prayer. Rev. Michael Hodsden, Moderator called the meeting to order. Rev. Justin Brown, Pastor of Zion Hill Baptist Church brought a devotion from Ephesians 6:10-13 and then led us in prayer.

Rev. Hodsden reported that we have 177 messengers representing 40 churches. Rev. Hodsden then reviewed the procedures that will be followed this evening.

- 1. The motion will be read.
- 2. The person who made the motion will be allowed to speak first.
- 3. Someone who opposes the motion will then be allowed to speak.
- 4. Each person will have three minutes to speak. Speakers will alternate (for then against) until all persons wishing to speak have spoken.
- 5. The vote will be taken and the motion must receive 67% of the voting body to pass.

The first motion to be addressed is the one concerning the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. (A copy of this motion is attached) Rev. John Crisp, Pastor of West End Baptist Church is the author of the motion and will be allowed to speak first. No one else spoke in favor of this motion. Those speaking in opposition of the motion were: Dr. Eldridge Cullum, Pastor of First Baptist Etowah and Wade Shultz of First Baptist Etowah. With no one else wishing to speak, a call for the vote was issued. Rev. Carl Creasman, Bylaws Director thanked the committee for their work on these motions. The Committee consisted of: Rev. Justin Brown, Zion Hill; Rev. Kevin Cheatham, First Baptist Calhoun; Dr. Jason Clark, First Baptist Athens; Dr. Jon Hathcock, East Athens; Dr. Bill Vest, Wildwood; our Moderator, Rev. Michael Hodsden and our Associate Moderator, Rev. Stan Hammonds. He also thanked Dr. Jon Hathcock and East Athens for opening their church for this meeting. Rev. Creasman then advised the members of the impact this motion will have if it passes. If this passes, no church in the McMinn-Meigs Association will be allowed to have any affiliation with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. If it fails, it will simply be in the hands of the local church. He reminded us that the Tennessee Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention dealt with this for many years (back in the 1990's) and even after the approval of the Baptist Faith and Message 2000. In response to this question, the Baptist Faith and Message was revisited and revised in 2000. The Tennessee Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention chose not to directly address the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. At this time, he instructed everyone to take their yellow ballot, and circle yes or no. Any other markings will disqualify the ballot.

The second motion to be addressed is the one concerning female Deacons. (A copy of this motion is attached) Rev. Doug Alexander, Pastor of Union McMinn Baptist Church is the author of the motion and will be allowed to speak first. Those speaking in favor of this motion: Jacob King, Union McMinn, Jodie Moser, Union McMinn and Travis Torbett, Marshall Hill. Those speaking in opposition of this motion were: Charles Ross, Goodsprings; Dr. Eldridge Cullum, First Baptist Etowah; Rev. Jamey Davis, First Baptist Decatur; Rev. Gerald Perry, Mount Pisgah; Rev. Josh Duncan; Lakeside and Cullen Conner, First Baptist Decatur. Rev. Josh Duncan, Pastor of Lakeside Baptist Church posed the question: What if a church says they want a woman who is a Deaconess? Since the Bylaws read "Deacon", they say "we want to be in the Association, ours is a Deaconess". Rev. Carl Creasman, Bylaws Director answered "the way the motion is worded at this time, is it says that the office of Deacon shall be reserved for men". "If this passes, and some church decides we want a woman, but we're going to call her a Deaconess then that is an issue that the Credentials Committee would have to evaluate and come back and report on. 


During this quarter, I have worked in the office and on the field 34 days, volunteered at Hickory Flats Baptist Church one day, was at the DOM Retreat 3 days, and served as a volunteer missionary in Nicaragua 8 days.

The churches I have visited include: Calvary Missionary, Riceville First, Old Salem, Pisgah (2), McMahan Calvary, Antioch (2), Rocky Mount (2), Lakeview, East Athens, Union Grove Decatur, West End, Dixon Avenue, Zion Hill, Mount Harmony Niota, New Bethel, Wildwood, New Zion, Eastanallee, Mount Harmony Riceville, Calhoun First, Niota First and Hiwassee in this association and Shiloh in Polk County and Glenlock (4). I also visited Camp Cherokee during their Youth Day Camp. I presented frame certificates to Pisgah, Wildwood and New Zion recognizing their gifts to the Golden Offering for State Missions.

I have conferred with at least 91 people in person or by phone. I have written 14 letters and 3 articles for the newsletter. I have had the privilege to preach 15 times. I have attended the meetings of the Credentials Committee, Nominating Committee and the Called Session of the Association.

I have served as Chaplain at Sweetwater Hospital 10 days and visited and prayed with 353 patients with 2 professions of faith and 2 rededications.

Furthermore, we will adhere to God's Word, faithfully and uncompromising, as we continue in the Baptist faith serving our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.





Rev. Stan Hammonds, Associate Moderator, called the 92nd Annual Meeting of the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists to order. We began the meeting with a video message from Dr. Randy Davis, Executive Director-Treasurer of the Tennessee Baptist Convention. Dr. Davis reminded us that Tennessee Baptists are attempting some mighty great things across our state for the next several years to accomplish for the glory and honor of our Lord. We will pursue five distinct objectives that were affirmed during the 2014 Summit. Objective one: seeing at least 50,000 Tennesseans annually saved and baptized by the year 2024. Objective two is to revitalize at least 500 Tennessee Baptist churches who are at risk of closing their doors within the next ten years. Objective three: planting at least 1,000 new churches; objective four: increase our cooperative program and our associational giving to rise; and objective five: double our Golden offering. Please pray that God will do in Tennessee what's never been done before. Jean Eledge, Minister of Music at First Baptist Church Calhoun, along with the choir led the congregation in singing "Say Amen". Rev. Kevin Cheatham, Pastor, welcomed the messengers to First Baptist Calhoun, shared Jonah 3:1-10; Jonah 4:1-4 and led in an opening prayer.

Rev. Stan Hammonds, Associate Moderator presented the program for the 92nd Annual Meeting (found on page 2 of the Book of Reports) for adoption. The motion carried.

Registration of Messengers: we have 183 messengers representing 41 churches present this evening.

New Pastors were recognized as follows: Rev. Ray Luck, Pastor of Oak Grove Baptist Church and Rev. Larry Arwood, Pastor of Antioch Baptist Church.

Announcements: that Pope Avenue Baptist Church will serve as the Host Church for the 2016 Annual Meeting on Monday, October 17, 2016.

Business Session:

Ken Jones, Chairman of Personnel Committee thanked the other members of the Personnel Committee who have worked for the past 16 months to bring the following proposal to this assembly.

We recommend that Rev. Mike Farmer be elected as Director of Missions for the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists. Rev. Farmer had served as the Pastor of First Baptist Church Niota for the past 18 years. He shared briefly about his salvation experience, his family, his educational background and his pastoral experience. He then shared his vision concerning the position of Director of Missions and for this Association.

A brief time was given for questions for the Personnel Committee and Rev. Farmer. No questions were asked, and a call for a vote was given. The vote was: 137 yes, 45 no for a total of 182 votes.

- Rev. Stan Hammonds, Associate Moderator, presented the presented the Treasurer's Report for this past year, noting that our receipts were down 6% from last year but our expenses were also down 22%. The reports were accepted as printed. Rev. Hammonds then presented the proposed budget for the coming year (found on page 8 & 9 in the Book of Reports). The upcoming budget does show an overall decrease of 7.34%. The budget was accepted as printed. Motion carried.
- Dr. Bill Vest, Chairman of the Nominating Committee presented the Nominating Committee and the Committee on Committee reports found on page 11 & 12 in your Book of Reports. While most of the leadership positions have been filled, there are a lot of openings in the committees for our Association. The report passed as printed.

• Rev. Oran Creasman presented the following report from the Credentials Committee:

The credentials committee has found ten (10) of our sister churches out of compliance with our bylaws. Three (3) have not given financially to the association this year. Four (4) have not turned in an annual church letter. Two (2) have neither given financially nor turned in an annual church letter. One (1) has an ordained woman deacon and gives financially to the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship.

Several churches were contacted by letter a few months ago about being out of compliance. Some of those have come into compliance. One church has been visited and discussions ensued about their non-compliance.

- 1. Since the goal of this committee and the tenor of scripture is to bring about restoration, and since the credentials committee has not been active in enforcing these bylaws during the last several years, the committee makes the following recommendations:
- 2. That each of these churches be contacted personally during the coming church year. During these visits, the churches should be encouraged to find a resolution suitable to be able to join together for the cause of Christ.
- 3. That each church be given this year to come into compliance.

That each church which does not come into compliance will be brought to the association annual meeting in 2016 and be brought for dismissal at that time according to our bylaws.

We believe that grace should reign in our hearts at this time. We believe that every opportunity should be given to find a suitable solution to each church as we seek to honor our Lord and witness to our world of a risen Savior.

No discussion. The motion passed.

Denise Bronaugh from the Tennessee Baptist Convention, thanked us for our support of the Cooperative Program.

Danette Reeves of First Baptist Calhoun sang "He's Always Been Faithful".


Rev. Carl Creasman, ByLaws Director read the Resolutions Report as printed in the Book of Reports on page 13. Motion approved to accept report as read.

I would also like to thank the members of the Stewardship Committee who have served faithfully this year. They were called on often this year, and I am appreciative of all their dedicated concern.



What is a Baptist Association?

(An Association is what the churches make it.)

A Baptist Association is a self-governing fellowship of autonomous churches sharing a common faith and active on mission in their setting.

- 1. The churches of an association are free, independent, self-governing, autonomous churches that decide to associate themselves to do certain things together.
- 2. The fellowship of churches involves oneness, shared life, mutuality and koinonia. It is a "family" of churches and a network, in which churches give and receive assistance. The association as a fellowship emphasizes the relationship existing among the churches.
- 3. Sharing a common faith The fellowship of an association is grounded in harmony in faith and practice. Associations differ in regard to the particular doctrinal issues that are important to their fellowship and in regard to the amount of diversity encouraged or tolerated on those issues. Nevertheless, the association, unlike state conventions, is a doctrinally based fellowship.
- 4. Active on mission refers to God's mission for the churches individually and the churches together in association. The first responsibility of each church is to deal with the same question, "What is God's mission for us together?"
- 5. In their setting deals with everything anyone means when he or she says of his or her association, "But I am in a peculiar situation." Every situation is peculiar, that is, unique; and it is in the uniqueness of that situation that an association of churches has a very special responsibility to be on mission. Associations differ from one another in such ways as size; geographical territory; population; cultural, ethnic, religious, socioeconomic and demographic characteristics of the area; number, strength and types of churches; history; relationship to the state convention; and stage of development.
- 6. Self-governing An association is created by the churches and is accountable to those churches through the messengers. An association, like other general bodies of Baptists, (state conventions, Southern Baptist Convention), is self-governing.

A Baptist Association is what the affiliated churches decide to make it. The messengers and executive board members selected by the churches make those basic decisions. The churches decide again what their association will become when they decide what percentage of their church budgets will go to associational missions.

Southern Baptists are committed to Bold Mission Thrust in a general way. You can be a part of what's happening in a specific way through involvement in your church and association.





McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Incorporated BY-LAWS

Article I – Existence, Purpose and Relationship

- Section 1: The McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc. exists because Southern Baptist Churches have chosen to join together in fellowship, evangelism and missions.
- Section 2: The purpose of the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc. is to equip, resource and encourage one another to be faithful Kingdom Servants in obedience to our Lord's Great Commission.
- Section 3: The McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc. shall maintain a cooperative relationship with the Tennessee Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention in a world mission program.

Article II – Voting Body

- Section 1: This Association in session shall be composed of messengers duly elected by the Southern Baptist Churches in McMinn and Meigs Counties who are affiliated with this organization. The affiliated churches shall be those that choose or elect to cooperate with the principles and practices of the Association as set out in the Charter of Incorporation and as herein set out.
- Each church shall be entitled to two messengers and one additional messenger for each fifty members or fraction thereof after the first hundred with a maximum of ten messengers from any one church.
- Any church petitioning for membership in the Association shall make such petition through the Credentials Committee. Each church whose petition is approved by the Association shall then be placed under the watch care of the Association for one full year or until the next annual session of the Association. At that time, and providing the church has proven to be in sympathy and in accord with the tenets and practices of the Association, it shall then, by a majority vote of the association messengers present and voting, become a member in full standing. During the year of watch care, petitioning church shall have a voice but not a vote in Associational affairs, including the representation on the Executive Committee and messengers to the Association.
- As a condition of membership in the Association, member churches shall subscribe to the Articles of Faith as outlined in Article III, be expected to submit an annual church letter that will provide demographic information on the ministry and health of the church, contribute to the financial support of the Association, have no direct affiliation with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship and limit the ordained Biblical office of Deacon to men.

A. Articles of Faith

(1) The Credentials Committee shall contact any member church that fails to conform to the doctrinal positions contained in the adopted Articles of Faith document identified in Article III in order to bring that matter to their attention.


- (2) The Credentials Committee shall make every effort to determine the reasons for this nonconformance and restore the church to fellowship with the Association.
- (3) Should the efforts of the Credentials Committee outlined herein fail to resolve the issue, the Committee shall present a report along with recommendations concerning membership to the Association at the next annual meeting or a special called meeting of the Association called for the expressed purpose of dealing with this issue. No such action shall be taken without at least 14 days written notice to all affiliated churches.
- (4) A recommendation for the loss of membership from the Credentials Committee shall require a two-thirds majority vote of the messengers present and voting at the meeting in which said recommendation is presented.

B. Annual Church Letter

- (1) The Credentials Committee shall contact member churches that fail to present an annual church letter in order to bring the provisions of this article to their attention.
- (2) The Credentials Committee shall make every effort to determine if there is a problem preventing the submittal of the church letter and to make every effort to assist the church to understand the importance of this requirement and resolve any problem that may exist.
- (3) The Credentials Committee shall report their findings to the Association, at the next annual meeting. Should the Committee find that extenuating circumstances exist which prevent the church from complying with the provisions of this section or create a temporary hardship on the church, the committee may recommend a one year extension to allow the church ample time to work through the problem before the church loses membership in the Association. If there are no extenuating circumstances or hardship conditions existing the church shall lose membership in the Association. If any extenuating conditions or hardship conditions found are not corrected by the end of the extended year, the church shall lose membership in the association at that time.

C. Financial Support

- (1) The Credentials Committee shall contact member churches that fail to make a financial contribution to the associational missions program in an effort to determine the reason for such failure.
- (2) The Credentials Committee shall bring the provisions of this Article to the attention of said church failing to meet this requirement, in an effort to determine if a problem exists and in an effort to avoid the problem extending into future years.
- (3) The Credentials Committee shall report their findings to the Association, at the next annual meeting. Should the Committee find that extenuating circumstances exist which prevent the church from complying with the provisions of this section or create a temporary hardship on the church, the committee may recommend a one year extension to allow the church ample time to work through the problem before the church loses membership in the Association. If any extenuating conditions or hardship conditions found are not corrected by the end of the

extended year, the church shall lose membership in the association at that time.

D. Direct Cooperative Baptist Fellowship Affiliation

- (1) The Credentials Committee shall contact member churches that have a direct affiliation with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF).
- (2) The Credentials Committee shall bring the provisions of this Article to the attention of said church failing to meet this requirement, in an effort to determine the extent of the affiliation.
- (3) The Credentials Committee shall report their findings to the Association at the next annual meeting along with their recommendation.

E. Women Deacons

- (1) The Credentials Committee shall contact member churches that ordain women to the Biblical office of Deacon.
- (2) The Credentials Committee shall bring the provisions of this Article to the attention of said church failing to meet this requirement.
- (3) The Credentials Committee shall report their findings to the Association at the next annual meeting along with their recommendation.

F. Re-admission

Any church dropped from the rolls, as a result of Section 4, may thereafter petition for re-admission under all the terms and conditions herein above prescribed for admission of churches to membership.

Section 5:

If any member of the Executive Committee feels that fellowship should be withdrawn from any affiliated church for any reason not listed above, said member should follow the guidelines of Matthew 18:15-17. If it is, thereafter, deemed necessary, by the Association Officers, to withdraw fellowship from any church FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED IN SECTION 4, and to refuse to seat its messengers, such action shall be only by a two-thirds majority vote of those messengers present and voting at any annual meeting or special called meeting of the Association called for this expressed purpose, exclusive of the messengers from the said church. No such action shall be taken without at least 14 days written notice to all affiliated churches.

Article III – Articles of Faith

The currently adopted Southern Baptist Convention version of the Baptist Faith and Message shall be the doctrines adopted by this Association.

Article IV – Authority

The Association is an autonomous body and therefore reserves the right to determine Section 1: its own policies and direct its own business; it may refuse to seat messengers who are not in fellowship or doctrinal agreement with the body or if the church by whom they

are elected is not.

Section 2: The Association may advise, give counsel, and propose measures to the churches, but shall exercise no power or ecclesiastical jurisdiction over the churches. It shall have power, however, to withdraw fellowship from any church that departs from the doctrines and practices of Baptist Fellowship in accordance with the guidelines of

Article II, Section 4.

A church shall be considered a Southern Baptist Church in good fellowship with the **Section 3:** Association if said church accepts and follows the Baptist Faith and Message referenced in Article III hereof as well as the conditions identified in Section 2 of this Article.

Any question concerning fellowship with the churches shall be referred to the **Section 4:** Credentials Committee for review in accordance with Article II, Section 4 (A) before presentation to the Association.

Article V – Meetings

The Association shall convene annually in the Fall for the annual business session, **Section 1:** unless otherwise fixed by the Association in annual session. The Association may also come together in the spring for an Association Celebration emphasizing Evangelism and Missions in one special event.

Special Meetings: The Executive Committee of the Association may call the **Section 2:** Association into special session at a time and place set by the committee, with the provision that all affiliated churches must be notified in writing at least 14 days before the special meeting, said notice to give the time, place, and purpose of the meeting.

Article VI – Associational Year

The Associational year shall begin on October first and end on September thirtieth.

Article VII – Officers

The officers of this Association shall be a moderator, an associate moderator, a clerk, **Section 1:** a treasurer, and such other officers as may be authorized by the Association. The moderator of the Association shall have the same duties as the president of a corporation is generally understood to have. The moderator and the associate moderator shall not serve for more than one consecutive year, and provided further, that no person shall be eligible for election as moderator until he shall have been a member of the Association for a period of two years. Furthermore, one of the offices, moderator or associate moderator, must be filled by a bi-vocational minister or a layperson. The retiring associate moderator shall be eligible for election to the officer of moderator. The clerk and the treasurer shall be employees of the Association.

Section 2:

The officers shall be elected at the annual meeting by majority vote of messengers present and voting, and shall take office at the close of the annual meeting. They shall serve until the close of the next annual meeting of the Association, or until their successors are elected and installed, provided, however, that the retiring clerk shall continue in office as association clerk until the completion and publication of the Associational Minutes and completion of any other duties connected with his/her office for the past associational year.

Article VIII – Executive Committee

Section 1:

There shall be an Executive Committee of the Association which shall consist of the following: one lay member elected by each church of the Association from its membership; the Director of Missions, director or chairman of all organizations and committees authorized by the Association; and the pastors of all churches in the Association. The moderator, associate moderator, clerk and treasurer shall be exofficio members of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall meet quarterly at the Baptist Center, 350 North Congress Parkway, Athens, Tennessee, or at such other place as may be previously determined. The Annual meeting will serve as the meeting for the fourth quarter of the year of the Executive Committee and the Spring Celebration shall serve as the meeting for the second (2nd) quarter of the year for the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall also meet at the call of its chairman. Twenty members of the Committee representing a minimum of 10 member churches shall constitute a quorum necessary to transact business. At its third quarter meeting preceding the Annual Session of the Association, the Executive Committee shall select the director of all organizations which may be authorized by the Association and as nominated by the Nominating Committee. The organizational directors so selected shall take office immediately following the next annual session. However, following the selection by the Executive Committee, the newly selected organizational directors shall be asked to recommend, to the Committee on Committees, the members for their respective committee/organization for the ensuing year.

Section 2:


The pastor of any church organized as a result of a mission operated for not less than two years under the sponsorship of a church affiliated with the Association shall be a special member of the Executive Committee, with full voting privileges, until such times as said church shall have an opportunity to apply for and become affiliated with the Association.

Section 3:

The officers of the Association are to be the officers of the Executive Committee, with the moderator of the association serving as chairman. The officers of the Executive Committee shall meet to plan the agenda for each Executive Committee Meeting. This meeting shall occur with sufficient time to notify the members of the Executive Committee of the pending business for the upcoming meeting.

Section 4:

The purpose of this Committee shall be to care for every interest of the Association and direct its activities in the interim between the annual meetings and shall carry out the policies and will of the Association as so expressed. The Committee shall have power to fill vacancies, as nominated by the Nominating Committee, among the officers of the Association and the Board of Directors or committees which may occur during the year except representatives to the Executive Committee and may authorize the appointment of any special committee deemed needful to carry out its duties.

Section 5:

Nothing outside of or beyond the authority given by the Association to the Executive Committee shall be exercised, unless prior written notice of at least thirty days has been given all of the churches of the Association and the members of the Executive Committee, with the opportunity for any member to present his views to the vote of the Committee.

Article IX – Board of Directors

Section 1:

The Association shall have a Board of Directors composed of nine members. Six members are to be elected at the annual meeting and serve, along with the moderator, associate moderator and the treasurer, as the Board of Directors. The Director of Missions shall serve as an ex-officio member. The (six) directors are to be elected on a rotating basis, as provided in section 3 of this article.

Section 2:

The members of the Board of Directors must be members of churches within the Association, in good standing, and recognized for their knowledge and their loyalty to the programs of the Association.

Section 3:

The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected on a rotating basis, provided that in no case shall any person serve on the board longer than three years in succession. The first six members of the Board of Directors shall be elected as follows: two to serve three years; two to serve two years; and two to serve one year, and thereafter two Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc. to serve three years. Vacancies created by death, resignation or removal from the Associational territory shall be filled at the next annual meeting following the creation of such vacancy by election of a Director to serve the unexpired term. Any person having served on the Board of Directors for a period of three years shall be eligible for re-election after a period of one year.

Section 4:


The duty of the Board of Directors shall be to represent the Association in all legal matters and in such other matters as the Association or Executive Board directs, particularly as the real property owned by the Association, protecting the Association, where any process of law is required. Said Board may take such action as to the property holdings of the Association in the interim between the annual meetings, as the Board's discretion may be required or seem necessary or advisable, except that said Board may not take any action in direct conflict with the policy or direction of the Association or Executive Committee. The moderator of the Association shall serve as President of the Board.

Article X – Committees and Functional Directors

Section 1:

The Association shall also maintain the following Standing Committees and Functional Directors, categorized by function as Administrative, Ministry/Missions/Evangelism and Education/Resources as follows:

A. <u>ADMINISTRATIVE:</u> Committee on Committees, Credentials Committee, Executive Committee, Nominating Committee, Personnel Committee, Property and Grounds Committee, Stewardship Committee and Resolutions/Bylaw Director.

- B. MINISTRY/MISSIONS/EVANGELISM: Evangelism Committee, Missions Committee, Christian Builders Committee, Prayer Ministry Director and WMU Director.
- C. EDUCATION/RESOURCES: Media Committee, Christian Education Director, VBS Director, Bible Drill Director, Seminary Extension Director and Baptist Collegiate Ministries (BCM) Director.
- **Section 2:** The Committee on Committees shall be composed of three persons. The duties of this Committee shall be to recommend for election, at the following Annual Meeting, the members of the Standing Committees named in Article X, Section 1, with the exception of the Committee on Committees.
- Each of said standing committees, with the exception of the Committee on **Section 3:** Committees, shall be composed of not less than three but not more than nine members. Members of these committees shall be rotating members and shall be selected from the membership of those churches affiliated with the Association, and shall be subject to reappointment, provided that in no case shall any person serve on the same committee longer than three years in succession, and provided that no person shall serve concurrently on more than two committees, except ex-officio members of all standing committees, including the Committee on Committees.

Article XI – Parliamentary Authority

The parliamentary authority for the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc. shall be the rules contained in the current edition of Roberts Rules of Order newly revised in all matters that are not consistent with these Bylaws and any special rules of order the Association may adopt.

Article XII – Amendments

These By-laws may be amended at any annual meeting, two-thirds of the members present concurring providing at least 14 days written notice has been given to the member churches.

Officer, Organization Director and Committee Procedures

The following is information regarding the officers and standing committees of the McMinn-Meigs Association of Baptists, Inc.:

- 1. Officers are elected on an annual basis and all, except the Moderator and Associate Moderator, may succeed themselves on an annual basis.
- 2. The Nominating Committee of the Association shall recommend a list of officers and members of the Committee on Committees to the Executive Committee for approval at their third quarterly (July) meeting.
- 3. All officers and the nominated Committee on Committees shall assume their duties following the next Annual Meeting. However they can, between the Executive Committee July Meeting and the Annual Meeting, recommend, to the Committee on Committees, names of people to serve with them in their area of responsibility.

- 4. The Nominating Committee shall identify one person for the office of Moderator and one person for the office of Associate Moderator to be recommended for election at the annual meeting. The floor shall be open for additional nominees for the offices of Moderator and/or Associate Moderator, during the annual meeting. The Moderator and Associate Moderator shall assume their duties immediately following the conclusion of the Annual Meeting at which they are elected.
- 5. The Committee on Committees shall have the responsibility of recommending people to serve on the various standing and special committees of the Association, with the exception of the Executive Committee and the Committee on Committees.
- 6. Association organizations and committees named herein shall make written and/or verbal reports to the regular meetings of the Executive Committee and the Association Annual Meeting. The Executive Committee shall exercise authority over these organizations and committees only to the extent of determining whether they are working within the bounds of organizational structure of the Association

Association Officers and Organization Directors

The following is a description of the duties of the Association officers and organization directors. These Officers and directors are grouped according to the major categories of ministry of the Association.

A. ADMINISTRATIVE

- 1. **Director of Missions** The Director of Missions (DoM) is one of four paid employees of the Association and has the responsibility for giving general direction to the paid staff and volunteer leadership of the Association. He is to serve as an ex-officio member of all committees, giving direction as needed and necessary, train the Association leadership in regard to their duties as a committee or organization and help to cast a vision as to the future direction of the Association. A more extensive list of ministry duties can be found in the Job Description Section of the Association Policy Manual.
- 2. **Moderator** The Moderator shall preside at all meetings of the Association and shall serve as exofficio member of all committees and organizations of the Association. The Moderator shall appoint a parliamentarian at any business meeting where the Bylaws Director is absent, and attend to such other duties as the office may require. The Moderator shall work closely with the Director of Missions in all matters of business and future plans (see Association By-laws Article VIII, Section 1).
- 3. **Associate Moderator** The Associate Moderator shall be available to assume the duties of Moderator at any time the Moderator cannot fulfill said duties. He also shall serve as ex-officio member of all committees and organizations of the Association (see Association By-laws Article VIII, Section 1).
- 4. **Association Clerk/ Financial Secretary/Treasurer** This person shall be a full-time employee of the association serving under the direct supervision of the Director of Missions. She/he shall be responsible for all duties as assigned and shall also serve as office receptionist. She/he shall also serve as the Association Clerk and be an ex-officio member of the Executive Committee and other organizations and committees as is necessary for her/him to attend. She/he shall be responsible for taking minutes (or making sure someone is present to fulfill that duty) at all Executive Committee meetings and at the Annual Meeting of the Association transcribing and distributing such to the proper persons. She/he is charged with maintaining accurate financial records and reporting. This person shall also serve as ex-officio member of the Stewardship Committee. See Job Descriptions for a more extensive detail of duties.



- 5. Camp Cherokee Director shall have the responsibility of giving overall direction to the operation of the camp. This person shall keep the Association informed of the needs, schedule and vision for the camp. This person shall work closely with Camp Cherokee Committee in developing a maintenance schedule, usage schedule, fund raising system, and developing a vision for the camp. This person shall work closely with the Director of Missions and other key leaders keeping people informed about the ministry of the camp. This is a paid position (part time).
- 6. **Resolutions/Bylaws Director** has the responsibility to oversee the Association Bylaws, proposing amendments as deemed necessary and preparing resolutions for association adoption as appropriate. The Director shall enlist other association members to serve as a committee as necessary for the fulfillment of this responsibility. This individual shall serve as the Association Parliamentarian for all Association meetings.
- 7. **The Board of Directors** shall serve as the trustees (legal agents) for the Incorporated Association. This board is composed of nine members, six of which are elected annually on a rotating basis (two elected each year) at the Association Annual meeting. The other three members are the Moderator, Associate Moderator and Treasurer. The Director of Missions shall serve as exofficio member.
- 8. **Stewardship Director** shall be the chairman of the Stewardship Committee and shall give direction to the Association's stewardship of that which is received from our churches and other sources. This person and the committee shall also be available to our churches to help them with any stewardship needs they might have (developing a budget, organizing a stewardship campaign and other stewardship related matters as requested).

B. MINISTRY/MISSIONS/EVANGELISM

- 9. **Evangelism Director** shall serve as chairman of the Evangelism Committee. Along with the committee this person shall work to keep the Association focused on the main thing, reaching people with the Gospel of Christ. This person and the committee shall encourage our churches, through a variety of means, to be evangelistic in seeking to reach their community and beyond. They shall be available to our churches to assist them in developing ministries that are evangelistic in focus that they might be more effective in their outreach efforts. They shall also be charged with the development and implementation of an annual Association-wide Evangelism Rally.
- 10. **Missions Director** shall serve as the chairman of the Missions Committee and shall lead this committee in the responsibility for the development of the mission strategy for the Association.
- 11. **Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) Director** shall give general overall direction to the ministry of the WMU of the Association. She shall lead the WMU Council in planning various ministry/mission related events and shall, along with her leaders, be available to our churche
- 12. **Prayer Ministry Director** shall, in conjunction with the Association Prayer Council, be responsible for developing an overall ministry of prayer for the Association. Through encouragement and hands on leadership this person is available to our churches to assist them in establishing an ongoing prayer ministry in their church. This person would, when needed, form ad hoc committees to address special prayer needs as they arise.
- 13. **Christian Builders Director** shall serve as chairman of the Christian Builders Committee, coordinating the activities and projects of this committee, leading in outreach from our association to individuals and groups where the Christian Builders can minister through the use of their construction skills.

C. EDUCATION/RESOURCES

- 14. **Media Library Director** shall be responsible for maintaining and updating the Media/Resource Center at the Association Baptist Center and shall be available to our churches to help them develop and/or strengthen their existing Media ministry.
- 15. **Christian Education Director** shall be responsible for keeping our churches informed of the current trends in Sunday School ministry through correspondence, meetings and other means. This person shall also develop a team of leaders that would be available to go to churches to assist them in all areas of Sunday School ministry.

Additionally, shall be responsible for keeping our churches informed of the latest trends in the area of Discipleship Training. This person shall also build a team of age group leaders specifically focused on leadership development in the area of Discipleship Training. This person and his/her team of leaders should be available to go to churches to help them develop and/or strengthen their Discipleship ministry. Further, this person shall oversee all areas of continuing education provided in and through the Association.

- 16. **Vacation Bible School Director(s)** shall be responsible for organizing and coordinating the annual Association VBS Training Clinic. The Director(s) shall organize their leadership team and assure they are properly trained for the performance of their duties. The VBS Director(s) shall be available to serve as VBS consultants for the Association churches as requested.
- 17. **Bible Drill Director** shall coordinate all events related to the Association Bible Drill Ministry. This person shall set a date, secure a location, contact participating churches, secure judges and callers for the Association event. This person shall do everything possible to get the word about Bible Drill to our churches and encourage them to provide the opportunity for their children and youth to be participants.
- 18. **Seminary Extension Director** The Director of Missions shall serve as the Seminary Extension Director. He shall employ a teacher who has the responsibility of teaching two to three classes per year, recruiting students and helping them to set the curriculum for the year. This person is paid a fee per class taught.
- 19. **Baptist Collegiate Ministries (BCM) Director** receives a small stipend from the Association and shall be responsible for coordinating the ministry of the BCM ministry at Tennessee Wesleyan College in Athens, TN under the direction of the Tennessee Baptist Convention and in cooperation with the Association.

ASSOCIATION COMMITTEES

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

The following is the list of Association Standing Committees and their duties and composition. These Committees are grouped according to the major categories of ministry of the Association.

A. ADMINISTRATIVE

1. **Committee on Committees** – The Committee on Committees shall have the responsibility of recommending people to serve on the various standing and special committees of the Association, with the exception of the Executive Committee. Members of the Committee on Committees shall serve for one year only and may not serve consecutive terms.

- 2. **Credentials Committee** shall receive and consider all applications from churches seeking membership in the Association. They shall study carefully the doctrines, practices and organization of each church seeking membership. They shall determine if said churches are in good standing with their sister churches. Their findings shall be conveyed to the Association at its next annual meeting from the time of application. It shall also be the responsibility of this committee to visit and advise any church of the Association which is reported to have departed from the doctrines and practices of the Association as set forth under Article II and III of the By-laws of this Association. Their findings and recommendations shall be reported at the next annual meeting of the Association. This rotating committee shall be composed of three members.
- 3. **Executive Committee** shall consist of the following: one lay member from each member church; the Director of Missions, all organizations directors and committee chairmen and all Pastors of member churches. The Moderator, Associate Moderator, Clerk and Treasurer shall be ex-officio members of the Executive Committee. The committee shall meet quarterly at the Baptist Center, 350 N. Congress Parkway, Athens, Tennessee, or at another location as determined. The annual meeting of the Association shall be considered as the fourth quarter meeting of the Executive Committee. The Moderator has the discretion to call special meetings of the Executive Committee, as needed. Twenty members representing a minimum of 10 churches of the Executive Committee present and voting shall constitute a quorum. The Executive Committee shall be charged with the care of the interests of the Association in the interim between annual meetings. Other duties of the Executive Committee can be found in Article IX Sections 1-5 of the Association By-laws. The following shall be considered the guidelines for the conducting of Association Executive Committee and Annual meetings:
 - 1) A place shall be made on the Order of Business of the Executive Committee and Association Annual Meeting for miscellaneous business.
 - 2) One sermon shall be provided at each Association Annual Meeting
 - 3) The Moderator shall take the chair at the time to which the Association stood adjourned. The Executive Committee and Annual Meetings shall be opened and closed with prayer.
 - 4) The Moderator shall preside over the deliberations of the body, and see that good order is preserved, calling to order if necessary, and reminding members of their duty.
 - 5) Any member wishing to address the Association shall rise in his/her place, and address the Moderator. If more than one seems to address him at one time, he shall name the member to occupy the floor.
 - 6) The Moderator shall decide points of order, subject to an appeal from his decision to the Association. He shall have the preference to speak or explain when an appeal is taken from his decision.
 - 7) Any member may call for a point of order, and the member so-called shall take his seat until the one who made the call shall have time to make their point clear and distinct, and then shall be open for debates and explanations. No person shall speak more than once to any point of order except by leave of the association.
 - 8) The Moderator may name any member to fill the chair, but such substitutions shall not extend beyond adjournment; no motion shall claim his attention unless it is seconded, or shall be open for discussion until formally announced by him.

- 9) The order of business of the Association shall be such as shall be adopted from time to time by the Association, and shall be subject to change or amendment at the pleasure of the Association.
- 4. **Nominating Committee** Shall present, at the July meeting of the Executive Committee, nominations for the Board of Directors and Association officers (see Association Bylaws, Article IX, Section 1) and the Committee on Committees. This committee shall also present, at the annual meeting, one nomination for the position of Moderator and one nomination for the position of Associate Moderator for election at the annual meeting. This rotating committee shall be composed of three members.
- 5. **Personnel Committee s**hall recommend staff personnel to fill vacancies occurring during the Association year, and recommend a person or persons to be added to the present staff, at such time as the Association may direct additional personnel to be employed. The committee shall have the power to recommend salaries, define vacations, hear grievances, act on fringe benefits, accept resignations and define the duties of employees. This rotating committee shall be composed of three members.
- 6. **Property and Grounds Committee** shall be responsible for maintaining in good repair all equipment, buildings and properties of the Association, except Camp Cherokee, which shall be under the supervision of the Camp Cherokee Committee. This rotating committee shall be composed of three members.
- 7. **Stewardship Committee** shall prepare annually a proposed budget for the Association and present such to the annual meeting for adoption. They shall be available to our churches to help them develop methods of supporting the budget. They shall consider all matters of finances referred to it by the Association, Board of Directors and the Executive Committee. They shall also give general supervision to the entire Association finance program, including current operational expenses, financial obligations assumed by the Association and planning and direction in regard to all capital needs and capital investments of the Association. The Treasurer shall be an ex-officio member of this committee. They shall be responsible for auditing all financial records of the Association and obtaining periodic independent audits. This rotating committee shall be composed of six members with the Stewardship Director serving as chairman.

B. MINISTRY/MISSIONS/EVANGELISM

- 8. **Evangelism Committee** shall be charged with the responsibility of motivating and encouraging our churches in the area of evangelism. This is done by providing opportunities for our churches to learn of new methods in the area of evangelistic outreach, providing training sessions, organizing and conducting an annual evangelism conference, crusades and encouraging churches to reach new people and bring them into the church through baptism. This rotating committee shall be composed of three members with the Evangelism Director serving as Chairman.
- 9. Missions Committee shall have the responsibility for the development of the mission strategy for the Association. They shall look at the various needs that exist in the area and develop ministries to meet those needs. They shall also focus on other mission opportunities outside the Association determining the direction the Association will take in the area of International and North American mission volunteerism. Determine the local ministries that the Association needs to develop or support and lead our churches and individuals to be involved. Determine methods that can be used to support and encourage continuing mission education in our churches. This rotating committee shall be composed of six-nine members with the Director of Missions, Moderator, Associate Moderator, and WMU Director serving as exofficio members.

10. **Christian Builders Committee** – shall have the responsibility to answer the call of individuals and groups where the Christian Builders can minister through the use of their construction skills. This committee shall consist of six to nine members recommended by the Christian Builders Director who shall serve as Chairman of this committee.

C. EDUCATION/RESOURCES

11. **Media/Library Committee** – shall be charged with the responsibility of maintaining an up to date Media/Library/Resource Center at the Baptist Center. They shall also be available to assist our churches in the development of or strengthening of their Media/Library Centers and to set Association wide training programs as needed during the course of a given year. This non-rotating committee shall be composed of three members with the Media/Library Director serving as chairman.
